# ICJI GRANT AWARD

As of January 1, 2024, Hope's Voice was awarded the SAVAF Grant (Sexual Assault Victim Advocacy Fund), which expands to include prevention of sexual violence in Knox and Daviess Counties while dually implementing a new position dedicated to sexual assault response. This funding will educate and promote violence prevention across Knox and Daviess counties with widespread information campaigns, evidence-based material creation, and information dissemination to foster health equity development across the diversifying populations in Knox and Daviess counties.

The CFS Prevention team successfully piloted health promotion campaigns at North Knox and South Knox schools for the last four years. Health promotion materials for the SAVAF grant model the CDC's technical packages made to reduce violence in the communities. Hope's Voice and the Prevention team are excited to embark on this new project!

# HEALTH CARE NAVIGATION

Navigating the health care system can be challenging and having the appropriate insurance coverage is an extremely important part of prevention. Studies confirm that health coverage improves access to care, supports positive health outcomes, incentivizes appropriate use of health care resources, and reduces financial strain on individuals, families and communities. CFS Corp., in collaboration with Covering Kids and Families, has brought on a trained health care navigator to the Knox County area. Our navigator will be available at the Margaret Compton Recovery Hub on Thursday's from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm for appointments and walk-ins, with hopes to expand these hours in the future!
